

Oakdale Primary School students wear their uniform with pride. Our uniform shows that we are part of the Oakdale Primary School community. We have the highest expectations from our students with regards to school uniform and appearance and strongly believe that our high standards promote positive behaviour, support effective teaching and learning and contribute to the ethos of the school.

### Jewellery

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear jewellery. The exceptions to this rule are stud earrings or sleepers in pierced ears, and small objects of religious significance. Children are required to remove any items or tape over earrings, with plasters provided by home, during PE lessons to prevent them from causing injury. Please note: Teachers are not permitted to remove earrings and the children are responsible for keeping their belongings safe.

No other body piercings are allowed.

## Uniform Policy 2025

We encourage all our children to wear their uniform smartly. All items of uniform must be named.

However, all items can be purchased via High street stores, and it is not expected that parents must purchase products with the school logo.

### Hair and Make up

Hair bands/bows should not be too large. Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school. Extreme hairstyles are not appropriate for school and children should not have decorative patterns cut into their hair or have hair coloured or dyed.

Hair should be worn up or tied back.

### **The Role of Governors**

The governing body supports the Headteacher in implementing the school uniform policy. It is the governors' responsibility to ensure that the school uniform meets all regulations concerning equal opportunities. Governors ensure that the school uniform policy enables children to dress sensibly, in clothing that is hardwearing, safe and practical.

Non-compliance with the uniform and appearance policy: Parents of students who do not wear the correct uniform will be contacted and requested to bring in a change of clothes for their child .

Students who wear make-up/nail varnish or jewellery will be required to remove these. Items of jewellery will be confiscated by the teacher to be collected by the parent. Persistent and defiant non-compliance with the policy will result in an appropriate sanction which may include reflection or exclusion.

All children will be expected to attend school in PE kit on their PE days.

Designer labels should not feature.

Large rucksacks are not acceptable. The children only need a bag to transport their reading book and water bottle to and from school. A small drawstring/ bookbag can be used.

All resources are provided by the school. Children do not need a pencil case and these should not be used in school.



# Uniform

School uniform gives a sense of belonging and pride in the school. We expect children to be in the correct uniform daily



- Oakdale Royal Blue sweatshirt/cardigan
- White polo shirt (with logo if preferred)
- Grey tailored trousers/ skirt/ shorts/ pinafore
- Black/ grey/ white socks plain/ grey tights
- Black shoes (no trainers or boots) Sandals are not permitted for summer use due to health and safety.
- Coat appropriate for the season
- Optional: During the summer months children may choose to wear a blue/white checked dress.

# PE kit
